



Boarding Contract

Monthly payments for horse board is due the first of the month; any payment owed after the 10th will be charged a late fee of \$25.

Make checks payable to "Rockingham Farm LLC." You may leave your check in the black box at the Farm or mail to:

- Thirty day notice required for leaving the Farm. Board will not be prorated.
- Negative Coggins is required to be kept on file at the Farm, yearly update required.
- Riding helmets are to be worn at all times while riding.
- Full-boarded horses will be brought in daily. Blanketing of full board horses will be done as necessary. Stalls will be cleaned six days per week except on major holidays. Sunday is our day of rest.
- Pasture-boarded horses will be brought in during inclement weather at Rockingham Farm's discretion.
- All horses will be fed up to two times per day, based on their own individual need. Hay and grain will be provided daily. Should your horse require different feed, Owner will pay the difference. A surcharge may be required for any horse requiring more than half a bale per day due to drought and hay shortages.
- All horses will be wormed twice yearly by Management and Owner will be billed.
- All horses must be vaccinated annually against Eastern and Western Encephalitis, Influenza, Tetanus, Rhino, WNV, Rabies and Coggins test. Copies of current medical records must be provided to Rockingham Farm.
- Farrier and Veterinarian visits should be arranged on your own. Payments are to be paid directly to them. We will notify you when we are scheduling them if you want to be included.
- Owner will be held responsible for any and all injuries caused to or by their horses while at this facility.
- Rockingham Farm will not be responsible for any theft of equipment or tack.
- Horses are grouped together in the pastures according to temperament at the discretion of Rockingham Farm.
- Clean up after your horse when they are in the cross-ties, indoor arena or wash stalls or other public area.
- All Owners are urged to insure their individual horses.
- No smoking in the barns or on the Farm.
- Do not borrow another person's tack, equipment, or supplies with permission of the owner. This includes fly spray and other consumable items.
- Do not ride another person's horse without permission.

- Children under the age of 10 must be supervised while at the barn by a parent or responsible babysitter.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash and be well-behaved. Free kennels are available at the upper barn.
- Positive attitudes are needed! Treat others as you would like to be treated
